

Call for Nominations and Applications: The Canadian Journal on Aging

The Canadian Journal on Aging / La Revue canadienne du vieillissement is seeking nominations or applications to fill several positions on the Editorial Board. These include: **Health Sciences and Biological Sciences, Psychology, Social Sciences and Social Policy and Practice Section Editors.**

Section Editors assume responsibility for managing the editorial process for submissions to the journal within the designated area. This includes selecting appropriate reviewers, overseeing revisions and resubmissions, and making recommendations regarding publication to the Editor-in-Chief, through an online review process. Section Editors will also help to develop a network of peer reviewers, contribute to the overall direction and structure of the journal, and help to oversee the general editorial process. Section Editors are members of the Editorial Board of *The Canadian Journal on Aging/La Revue canadienne du vieillissement*, and are asked to participate in the Annual Meeting of the Editorial Board, held in conjunction with the CAG Annual Scientific and Educational Meeting. Travel expenses are covered.

Section Editors are expected to be recognized authorities in their respective specialty areas, and proficiency in both official languages (English and French) is an asset.

Appointment to the Editorial Board is normally for a four-year term. Nominations and applications will be accepted until positions are filled.
